Description

The Groenewei district of Meerstad, Groningen is the home of the new SuperHub Meerstad – a modern market hall that features a supporting structure made entirely of wood. The cross-shaped wooden pillars and beams in the roof give the building a cathedral-like appearance. The large span and a ceiling height of nine metres create a bright and airy feel inside the structure. The projecting roof is particularly striking with its elegant columns and net-like wooden trusses.

Problem

All the wooden elements needed to have the same final colour, even if they were made from different types of wood by different companies. Working closely with the architect and the building contractor, Remmers coordinated the technical aspects of the coating.

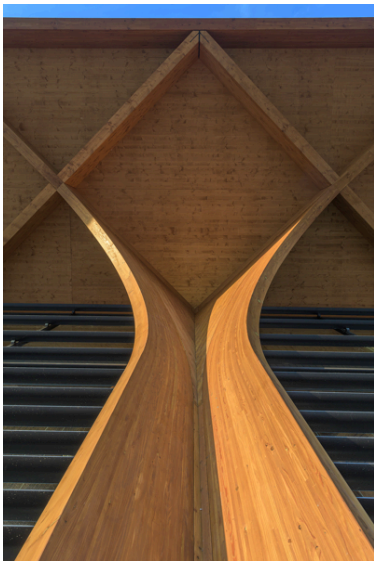

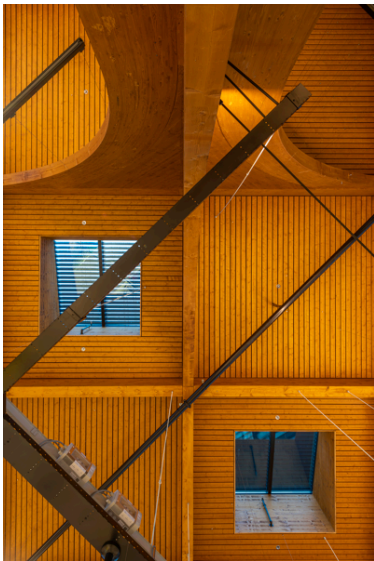

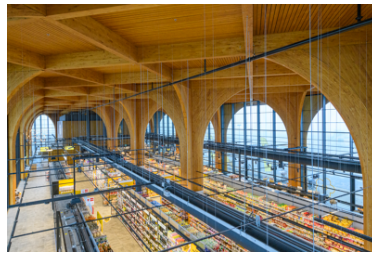
